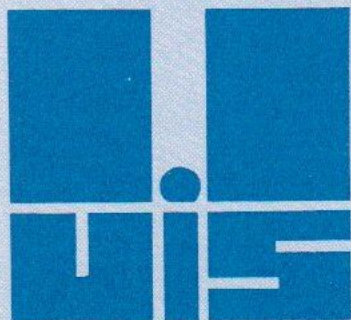
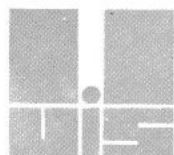


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Book and News

Abonarse a la revista significa disponer de el único instrumento de información y discusión científica en el campo de la Espeleología física y biológica.

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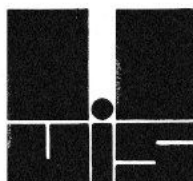
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
